Historical Society to meet

The Northumberland County Historical Society will meet at 2:30 p.m. October 7 at Ball Memorial Library and Museum at 86 Back Street in Heathsville.

Retired Lt. Colonel Myron "Mike" E. Lyman will present "The War of 1812 in the Northern Neck."

This year marks the 200th anniversary of the beginning of that war. Mr. Lyman notes that more battles took place in the Northern Neck during this period than in any other war. His presentation will center on those battles and on the local sites where confrontations with the enemy occurred. He will emphasize the events and consequences of that conflict for Northumberland County and its residents.

Lyman received a bachelor's in agriculture from the University of Vermont and also is a graduate of the U.S. Army's Command and General Staff College. He served in the U.S. Army Infantry with tours in Korea and Germany and combat in Vietnam. He is assistant historian general in the War of 1812 Society and past president of the Virginia Society, War of 1812.

Lyman has compiled War of 1812, Veteran Graves in Virginia, published in 2012 by Heritage Books. Earlier, he co-authored Encounters with the British in Virginia during the War of 1812, published in 2009.
