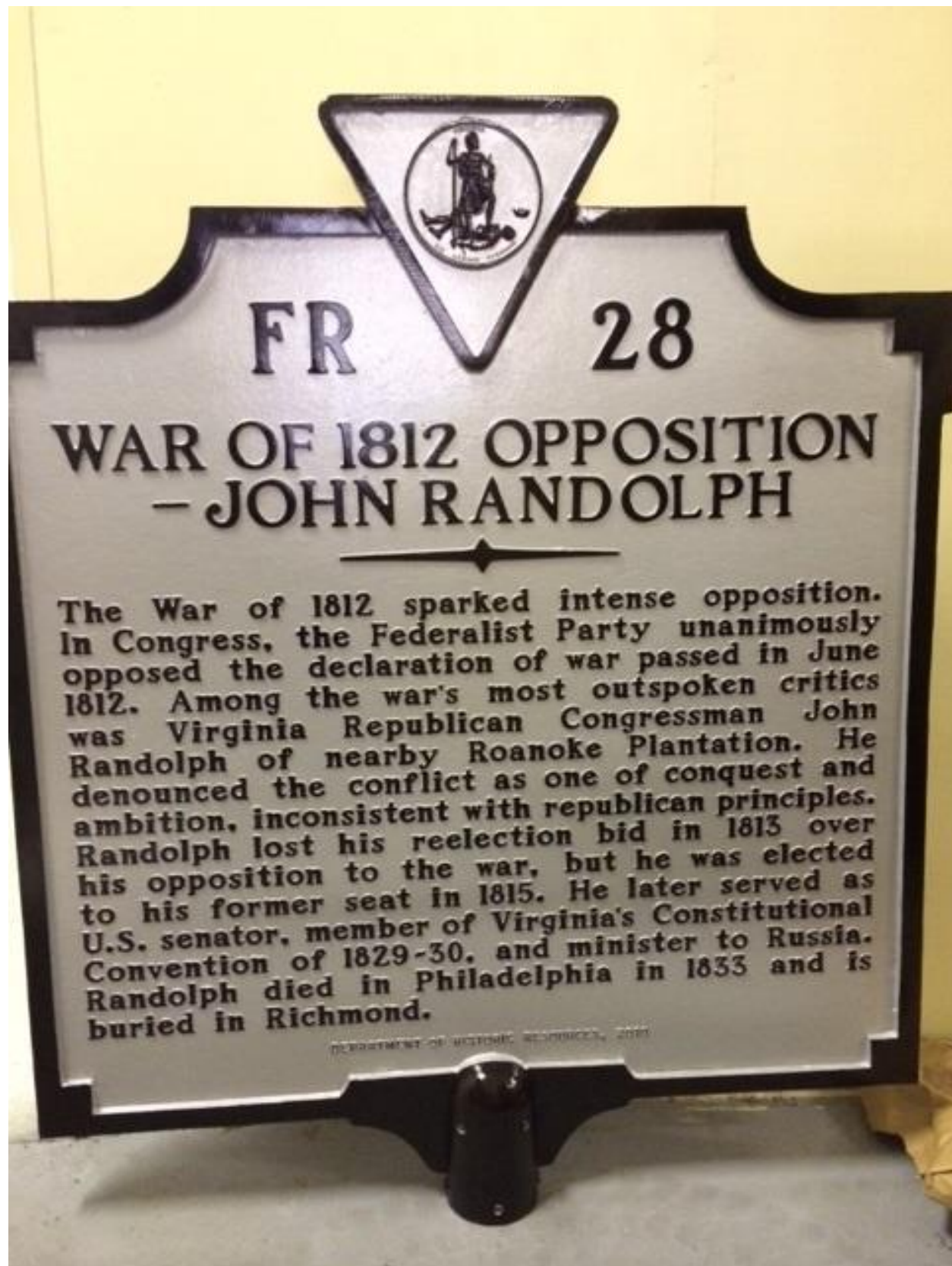

1.09 miles East of Route 607 (Roanoke Station Rd).

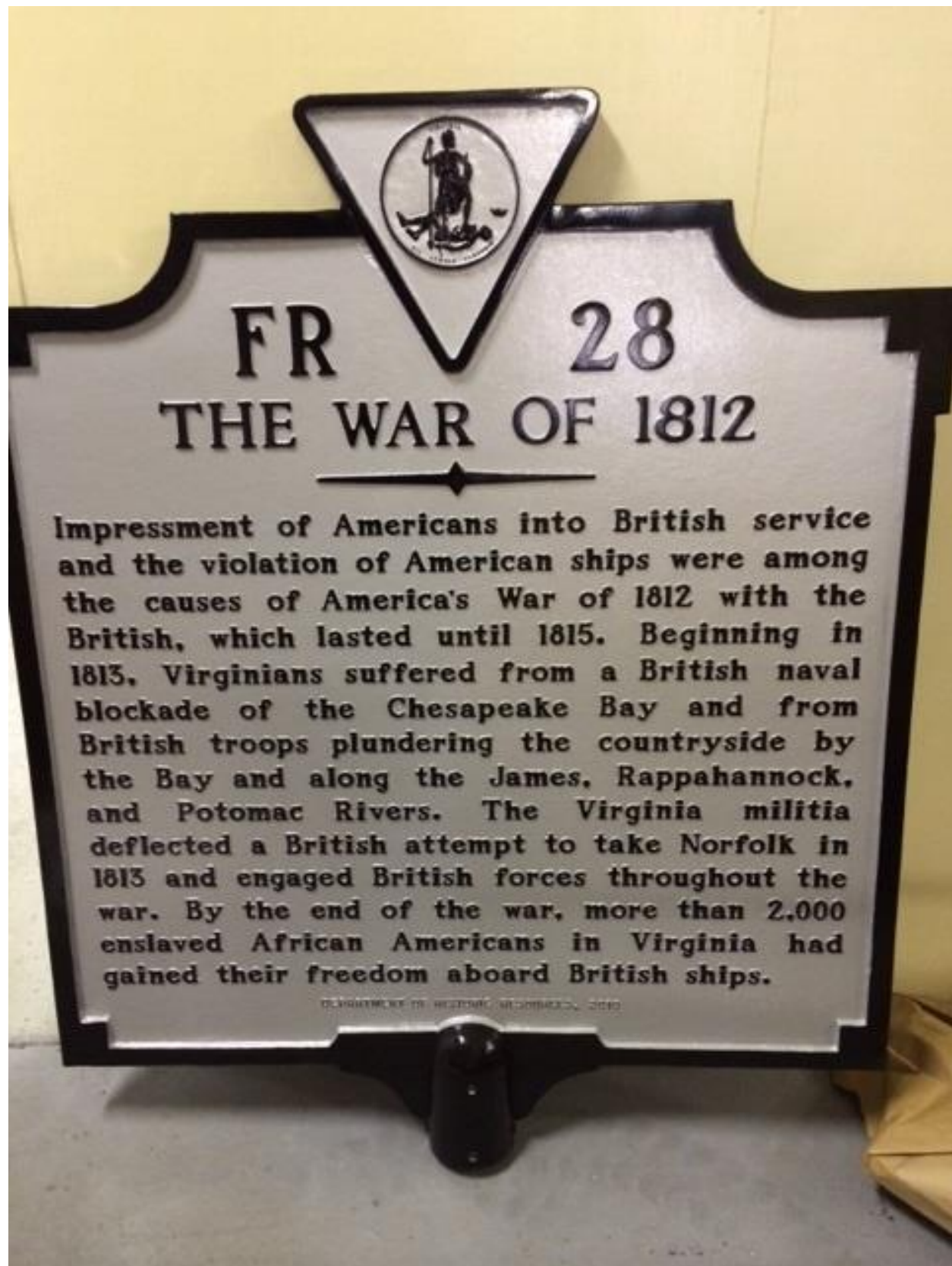
Historical Highway Marker site is located at a shoulder
